Sunshine Coast's Spring Wildflower Festival offers a wonderful selection of free,

guided wallum wildflower walks which allow the walker to experience these classically adapted species first hand.

See the carnivorous sundew - so tiny that to examine it you need to get a bug's eye view at ground level.
